<u>ANNUAL CUSTODIAN MEETING, KAREN RUSSO – DIRECTOR AND RELATIONSHIP MANAGER, SALEM TRUST COMPANY</u>  Ms. Karen Russo was in attendance via Zoom on behalf of the Salem Trust Company for her annual meeting with the Board of Trustees. Ms. Russo provided a brief overview of the current Trust accounts and daily processing activity levels. The Trust Fund has increased by five custody accounts since this same time last year. Ms. Russo noted it has been nearly five years since the Board hired Salem Trust. Ms. Russo thanked the Board for its continued support and ongoing relationship.						
<u>GREGG ROSSMAN LEGAL REPORT</u>  Mr. Rossman addressed a question raised by the Executive Director regarding the proper interpretation of the 8 <sup>th</sup> Amendment to the Office Lease as it relates to the 11.6% CAM fee currently being assessed. Mr. Rossman agreed with her interpretation of the Lease that the CAM fees should not increase to 11.6%, and further the base rent should not increase on 10/1/2025, until substantial completion of the work in suite 302, defined as the Commencement Date. The Executive Director noted that she and the building manager disagree on this issue and both agreed to consult with their respective attorney for clarification on the CAM fees. The Executive Director will forward Mr. Rossman’s legal opinion to the building manager. Mr. Rossman recommended having Grover Corlew’s attorney contact him directly to discuss the issues if they have a different interpretation.
